We are thrilled to announce that plans are underway for the 9th Annual Tusa Show Cattle Fall Retreat to be held November 20-21, 2021. A spin-off of our past summer camps, this retreat will offer a weekend full of hands-on educational experience for both today's youth and their parents. All participants will be given the opportunity to gain a better knowledge on important topics revolving around their show projects from well-known industry leaders to highly regarded academic professionals. Guest speakers will provide their insight on topics such as daily care, feeding and nutrition, showmanship, grooming/fitting, health maintenance, ethics, livestock evaluation, Texas Majors and more.

We will be spending a great deal of time with the youth on showmanship. The retreat will feature a jackpot showmanship competition and a separate buckle competition where division winners will receive BELT BUCKLES (1st place) & SCHOLARSHIPS (top 3) & PRIZES (top 10)!

The retreat is open to current and past clients of Tusa Show Cattle, as well as past camp participants and individuals who have requested to attend (based on availability).

Each youth participant must be accompanied by an adult. The event is being privately held for Tusa Show Cattle clients only. Non-Tusa Clients may be allowed to participate if allowed for an additional fee with permission of Tusa Show Cattle.

The registration fee includes a retreat t-shirt, cap, outerwear, retreat materials, meals including breakfast, lunch & dinner on Saturday and breakfast & lunch on Sunday, as well as miscellaneous drinks and snacks. *The registration fee does not include the \$5 cash gate entry fee for the jackpot showmanship show on Saturday afternoon which will be paid upon gate entry at the show.* It is mandatory for each family to complete the online retreat application form.

Retreat registration closes on [Friday, October 22.](#) Applications must be submitted through our website at tusacattle.com. Applications will be accepted on a *first come, first served* basis.

We appreciate your promptness as size orders for t-shirts & outerwear are needed well ahead of time to assure you will receive these materials. Please note: Camp registration fees are non-refundable. Anyone who submits an online application and cancels prior to October 22 will receive a full refund. All no-shows will be responsible for their retreat fees.

Showmanship Competitions

There will be two showmanship shows held during the Retreat. The age cutoff is set for September 1, 2021. The five age divisions are as follows:

9 & Under
10 & 11 year olds
12 & 13 year olds
14 & 15 year olds
16 thru 18 year olds

The **Jackpot Showmanship Show** on Saturday will be "winner take all" for each division. Youth Participants will be required to pay a \$5 cash entry fee at the gate. This cash entry fee is not included in your registration fee. There will be one or two winners selected in each age division (to be determined). The winners will receive a portion of the proceeds for their respective division.

The **Buckle Showmanship Show** on Sunday will be divided in the same age divisions as Saturday. There is no entry fee as this is included in your retreat registration. The judge will select a top 10 with the division winner receiving a belt buckle in memory of Charles W. Wilson III. ****Each Division winner will receive a \$1000 scholarship, 2nd Place will receive a \$500 scholarship and 3rd Place will receive a \$250 scholarship.** All places will receive awards which will be presented at the Awards Ceremony on Sunday.

What Do We Bring?

It is recommended that each youth participant *bring their own animal* to work with throughout the retreat. This allows more one on one instruction that specifically deals with the participant's animal. *****Participants are required to provide their own show stick, number harness and show halter. Other items to bring would be any item you would see necessary to attend a show for the weekend. A show supply trailer will be on hand for any items you may need to purchase.**

****Due to limited space, each family is asked to limit # head to one per youth participant. STALLING WILL BE AVAILABLE ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS!**

****Please note that if you have recently sold your animal for a fall fair, we can help accommodate your child with an animal to use during the retreat.**
